FEES

Application Fee - \$10 (non-refundable)

Table Rental - \$60 for a ten foot table and \$30 for a five foot table

IMPORTANT DATES

Applications due: March 15 (*postmarked March 15 or earlier*)

Acceptances mailed or emailed: March 21

Fees due: April 1

BASIC INFORMATION

- ALL WORK MUST BE HANDMADE BY THE APPLYING ARTIST - NO EXCEPTIONS
- Tables provided are approximately 10' wide x 3' deep (full table) and 5' wide x 3' deep (half table). Exhibitors must provide all necessary display equipment and stools for seating.
- Maximum of one ten foot table per exhibitor
- Most spaces have access to electricity
- No manufactured goods or imports
- No work produced with commercial kits, molds, patterns, plans, or prefabricated forms

TO APPLY

- Each artist wishing to participate must submit an application. Joint applications will not be accepted
- Submit 3-5 photographs of your work. One photo should be of the display from a previous show, if available. We prefer you send pictures by email. If you send print images and want them returned, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope. Application will not be reviewed without photos
- Enclose non-refundable application fee of \$10 with your application. Make checks payable to

Greensboro Farmers Market, Inc. **DO NOT SEND TABLE FEE WITH APPLICATION.** If you are accepted, you will receive an invoice for the table rental fee

- A charge of \$25 will be assessed for all returned checks
- Incomplete applications will not be returned
- Acceptance not guaranteed based on participation in previous events at this facility

SELECTION

- Applications will be reviewed by a committee of market management and knowledgeable volunteers
- All applicants will be reviewed for quality of products and display appearance
- The committee will accept artists after a thorough review of all applications
- All decisions of the committee are final
- Acceptance to one Craft show does not guarantee acceptance to future shows

Other Information

- Management reserves the right to remove from the show - without refund - any exhibit or portion of an exhibit that is not comparable to the submitted images. Works displayed for sale must be consistent with the images submitted with the application
- Management may also remove any item being exhibited that is not produced by the artist
- No "sale" and/or "show special" signs allowed
- In the event of cancellations, artists will be pulled from a ranked waiting list. Selection from the waiting list will be based primarily on media category
- Submission of completed application indicates applicant's agreement to these guidelines
- Greensboro Farmers Market, Inc. reserves the right to bar participants from future shows if these guidelines are not followed
- Setup time will be provided when invoices are issued

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

After booth fees are paid, applicants are entitled to the following refund of booth fees upon cancellation:

April 28 by 5:00 pm: 50% refund. After 5:00 pm April 28: No refund

The following media categories will be accepted:

All work must be the original work of the artist. Items made from manufactured kits purchased for resale will be removed from display and the artist will not be invited to return for another show.

- CLAY
- CRAFT
 - Candles - handcrafted candles of all types made by the artist
 - Leather - includes hats, handbags, belts, and other items tooled from leather by the artist
 - Personal care products- handcrafted soap, lotions, bath salts, etc.

- DRAWING
- FIBER (ART)-wearable
- FOLK ART
- FURNITURE
- GARDEN ART
- GLASS: blown, fused or stained
- PAINTING: decorative or fine art
- JEWELRY Personal adornment such as bracelets, necklaces and rings made by the artist: Beaded-from any material, glass-from glass using lamp-working and fused glass techniques, metalsmith-using traditional techniques.
- METAL WORK: forged or altered by the artist
- MIXED MEDIA - combining more than one media and/or technique to create a single work of art
- PHOTOGRAPHY
- SCULPTURE
- WOOD
