Rates

1. Applications & Deadlines

1.a. Renewal of Annual & Daily Vendors (Renewal Application Due: Nov. 5, 2022)	\$35 per category (Farm / Food Artisan / Craft)	\$50 late charge and subject to waitlist/loss of Annual status / processed as “New Application”
1.b. New & Guest Vendors	\$25 per category (Farm / Food Artisan / Craft)	
1.c. Educational & Non-profit Guest	No Fee-must sign the Community Table Agreement & Promote on Social Media	
Note: Additional markets (rate-based) may be offered throughout the calendar year for additional payments		

2. Annual Vendor Tables- Approved to sell from a reserved table for one calendar year while the market is open

2.a. 2023 Annual table payments are due by December 3rd, 2022. Invoices may be paid by cash, or check credit; a 4% convenience charge, is added to credit card payments. Split payment option available for vendors with two or more tables, by request – 50% due December 10, 2022, and 50% due no later than June 3, 2023. Delinquent payment of any outstanding balances will result in a \$50 per week late charge and the vendor is subject to waitlist and loss of Annual status.

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Note: Manager's discretion will be used in the placement of vendors inside(space permitting) due to inclement weather. All payments are non-refundable.

3. Daily Vendor Tables

4. Vendor- Wednesday Season- 26 potential weeks (April 19- October 18)

\$216 per season for twenty-seven dates or \$10 drop-in/ daily market. Mid-Week Wednesday Season vendors will be invoiced 90 days before season opening with payment due by March 18, 2023.

Note: Additional Markets out of season are not included in the mid-week market season.

6. Additional Markets and Equipment, Etc.

6.a. Markets – (subject to table availability)

GFM may offer additional markets, distribution models, or equipment access which may be offered for additional rates throughout the calendar year.

7. b. Equipment– subject to table availability

8. Request for Additional Items: \$10 processing charge shall be assessed for **each category addition/change**.

Applies to requests received after initial applications are approved and if it is a **new category**, i.e., craft to a farmer, for the Vendor, requires an appropriate category application and payment of associated rates (Section 1 above).

9. Insufficient Funds/Returned Check: \$50 charge

Fees

Under the GFM 2023 Vendor Guidelines: *Management may assess a fee on a Vendor, and/or otherwise suspend or revoke a Vendor's current, approved privilege to sell with GFM for failure to comply with the Vendor Guidelines.*

Management takes progressive action rather than applying maximum penalties for one infraction. Egregious or multiple infractions may receive immediate penalties or suspension from the Market. Outstanding warnings carry over from the prior year/season. If a fee is assessed, a vendor may not return to the Market until such fee is paid.

\$25 Fee: The first infraction will result in a written warning of non-compliance. Any subsequent violations will result in a \$25 fee due, and the Vendor may be temporarily suspended from the Market.

- Failure to arrive on time, i.e., later than fifteen minutes before the Market opens. Note that a Vendor arriving later than fifteen minutes before the Market opens without prior notification may be denied admittance. In case of emergency, the Vendor must notify Management of late arrival PH: 336-373-2402 and leave a message.
- Parking in customer parking during Market or failure to park in the designated Vendor parking
- Failure to notify Management of absence before midnight Thursday before Saturday Market (Annual Vendor or Daily Vendor in case of confirmed tables.) In case of emergency, the Vendor must notify Management of late arrival PH: 336-373-2402 and leave a message.
- Smoking within one hundred feet of Market facility entrances.
- Failure to remove vehicles from vendor loading zone or customer parking 30 minutes before Market opening.
- Use of cart in the market in aisles after opening or before closing.
- Failure to display required information in vending space. All Vendors must post signs including product prices individually or on a legible sign. In addition, Vendors must display their business name and production location.
- Failure to clean their area and remove trash/or recycling Failure to remove products and displays for special events (Market or Rental) or failure to leave tables in clean condition.

\$75 Fee: First violation will result in a written warning of non-compliance and a fee of \$75. Any subsequent violations will result in a \$75 fee and the Vendor may be temporarily suspended from the Market.

- Unprofessional conduct including disruptive, uncooperative, abusive, or offensive behavior or language; use of or being under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances; possession of firearms or other weapons.

\$100 Fee: First violation will result in a written warning of non-compliance and a fee of \$100. Any subsequent violations will result in a \$100 fee and the Vendor may be temporarily suspended from the Market.

- Selling items or products not approved on application.
- Failure to comply with Guidelines and direction by Market Management as related to Guidelines.
